Numbing numbers...

- 925 million people suffer from under-nutrition or hunger
- 2 billion people world wide suffer from nutritional deficiencies, such as insufficient vitamin A, iodine, iron, zinc, and folate.
- Vitamin A deficiency annually claims the lives of almost 670,000 children under the age of five.

16,000 humans die each day...

- Iron deficiency anemia during pregnancy is associated with 115,000 deaths each year, accounting for 20% of total maternal deaths.
- Under-nutrition is the underlying cause of the death of 3.5 million mothers and children under the age of five each year, and approximately 200 million children currently suffer the irreversible effects of chronic under-nutrition
- Children experiencing malnutrition do not achieve optimal growth, have heightened vulnerability to illness and suffer from diminished cognitive development.

On the home front...

- Malnutrition is not limited to developing countries. In developed countries, half of those over 75 in hospitals are thought to be nutrient-deficient, as are many obese people.
- Approximately 49 million people in the United States, including 17 million children live in households struggling to put enough food on the table (food insecure).
- One-half of all children will participate in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (previously known as the Food Stamp Program) at some point during their childhood, including 90% of African-American children.
- A study in the Journal of the American Dietetic Association found that the 2005 Dietary Guidelines market basket would require a low-income family to devote 43% to 70% of their food budget to fruits and vegetables.

Negligence, Incompetence...Indulgence

- A lack of dollars and cents...no common sense
 - 40% of harvest is lost in developing countries before it gets on the plate
 - Over 25% is thrown away in developed countries after it's on the table
 - 22 feeding programs in CA...no efficiencies
 - California ranks 50st place in SNAP utilization
 - California ranks in the bottom 10 of school lunch utilization
 - California leaves @ \$4 billion on the table...
