Departmental Application for Admission

Dear Applicant:

The Second Bachelor of Science in Communication Sciences and Disorders is offered through a partnership between the College of Health and Human Services and the College of Continuing Education at Sacramento State. The program is designed for individuals who hold a bachelor's degree (in any discipline other than Communication Sciences and Disorders or Communication Disorders), have completed the required prerequisites, and aspire to work and/or apply to a master's degree program in the speech pathology field.

Admission Requirements

To be considered for admission to the program, applicants must:

- Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 in the last 60 units of college coursework taken.
- Have all prerequisite courses completed with a grade of C- or better.
- Sign a contract of agreement stating that the student will not be employed for more than 20 hours per week when courses are in session.

Application Process

Applying to the program entails a two part process:

1. Apply to the College of Continuing Education (CCE) by filing the following materials as a complete admission packet (visit www.cce.csus.edu/csad2b for program dates and deadlines):

- a. Program Application
- b. One set of official, sealed transcripts of all colleges and universities attended other than Sacramento State.
 - i. We prefer that you submit all transcripts with your application, but if that is not possible, please indicate on page 1 of your application which transcripts will be submitted after the application deadline.
 - ii. Transfer credit included for one college on another college transcript is not acceptable.
- c. \$50 non-refundable application-processing fee (check or money order payable to Sacramento State).

Please submit the items in an envelope as a SINGLE PACKAGE (do not use staples, paper clips, post-it notes, sheet protectors, folders or binders) to:
