A complete outline of the paper to be submitted upon completion of the project should accompany this proposal contract. This outline should be written in accordance with the requirements for a graduate project: "a project is a significant undertaking of a pursuit appropriate to the fine and applied arts or to professional fields. It must evidence originality and independent thinking, appropriate form and organization and a rationale."

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4. Attach an annotated bibliography covering the objectives to be studied while traveling

This annotated bibliography should consist of no less than six references. The annotated bibliography should include reliable sources related to the topic and should follow k. Turabian, a manual for writers.

5. How will you meet these objectives?

Attach a specific step-by-step research design to include the question under investigation. Specific methodology used, procedures, and the manner in which the information will be presented should be explained.

6. Outline your itinerary

7. Required materials for project evaluation

- Scholarly, scientific inquiry is very essential and a requirement for graduate credit.
- Typed report (double spaced) in accepted university form.
- Length: 10 pages. Refer to a manual for writers, k. Turabian.
