OVERVIEW

School social work (SSW) is a challenging yet rewarding profession. In schools, social workers often serve as the liaison between parents/guardians, the school administration and the community. School social workers collaborate with other school officials to support students in reaching their academic and personal potential.

Completion of the Pupil Personnel Services Credential (PPSC) certificate will allow school social workers to serve as a resource to teachers for behavior and classroom management skills, and to gain the tools needed to address challenges and promote student success.

Eligibility

Post-graduate applicants

Social work professionals who have a Master's in Social Work (MSW) from a Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) accredited school may apply to this program. Transcripts must reflect coursework in social work practice with diverse populations.

Current Master in Social Work students at Sacramento State

Current MSW II students must successfully complete the degree requirements for MSW and PPSC in SSW program concurrently.

Current MSW I students must fill out a Declaration of Intent form before applying.

Although not required, students are highly encouraged to complete the LiveScan and receive your Certificate of Clearance as soon as possible.
